

## OFFICIAL CALL

### Mass Meeting of Brunswick County Republican Committee Of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Brunswick County Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, William L. Rogers, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be Held at the Lawrenceville Public Library, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor meeting room, starting at 7pm local time on 18 March 2016 for the following purposes:

- A. Electing up to 90 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 5<sup>th</sup> District Saturday, May 14, 2016 at beginning at 11:00 AM Nelson County High School Lovingston, VA OR An alternate site if necessary for the following purposes:
  - a) Election of 3 National Delegates for the 2016 Republican National Convention
  - b) Election of 3 Alternate National Delegates for the 2016 Republican National Convention
  - c) Election of 1 Elector for the 2016 Presidential Election
  - d) Election of 3 State Central Committee Members
  - e) Election of District Committee Chairman
  - f) Election of Candidate for 2016 Congressional Election
  - g) Transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention
    - a. he convention
- B. Electing up to 90 Delegates and alternatives to the Republican Party of Virginia's 2016 Quadrennial Convention (the "Convention") to be held at the James Madison University Convocation Center on April 29-30, 2016 beginning at 1430 hours for the following purposes:
  - a) Electing 13 At-Large Delegates ("National Delegates") and 13 At-Large Alternate Delegates ("National Alternates") to the Republican National Convention to be held on July 18-21, 2016, at the Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland, Ohio (or its alternate site) (the "National Convention");
  - b) Nominating two Electors At-Large to be voted for in the presidential election on November 8, 2016;
  - c) Electing a State Chairman;
  - d) Electing a National Committeeman and National Committeewoman;
  - e) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention.
- C. Electing a 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice Chairman for the Brunswick County Republican Committee
- D. And for the transactions of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the Committee is entitled to 18 Delegate Votes;

#### Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Brunswick County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principals of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

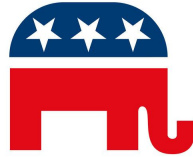
**Filing Requirements:**

Candidates for election to the position of Delegate to the 2014 RPV State Convention at said mass meeting shall file the correct 5<sup>th</sup> District and/or State Delegate form of intent to be elected as a delegate, by mail, email, or in person, to William L. Rogers, 500 Beagle Run Lane, Alberta, VA 23821 between the dates of 1 March 2016 to not later than 6:00 PM, on March 14<sup>th</sup> 2014. **Postmarks will not govern.** Filing forms MUST be used by delegate candidates and can be obtained by contacting either William L. Rogers at wlr107@mail.com, Eric Brazille at ericbrazz@gmail.com, or online at www.RPV.org. If fewer candidates file for Delegates than spaces available, all properly filed Delegates will be deemed elected and the Mass Meeting will be canceled. The cancellation of the mass meeting shall be posted on the Brunswick County (VA) Republican Committee Facebook page No Later Than 8:30pm on 16 March 2016.
