



## OFFICIAL CALL

### Mass Meeting of the City of Williamsburg Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the City of Williamsburg Republican Committee of the Republican Party (CWRC), and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Lori B. Goldstein, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the City of Williamsburg Regional Library, 515 Scotland Street, Williamsburg, VA 23185 beginning at 7 p.m. local time on Wednesday, March 23, 2016 for the following purposes:

1. Electing up to 80 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia's Quadrennial Convention, to be held on April 29, 2016 and ending on April 30, 2016, at the Convention Center of James Madison University, 895 University Boulevard, Harrisonburg, VA 22807 beginning at 2:30 p.m. EDT for the purposes of:
  - A. Electing 13 At-Large Delegates ("National Delegates") and 13 At-Large Alternate Delegates ("National Alternates") to the Republican National Convention to be held on July 18-21, 2016, at the Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland, Ohio (or its alternate site) (the "National Convention");
  - B. Nominating two Electors At-Large to be voted for in the presidential election on November 8, 2016;
  - C. Electing a State Chairman;

- D. Electing a National Committeeman and National Committeewoman;
- E. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention.

Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the City of Williamsburg Republican Committee is entitled to 16 Delegate Votes;

- 2. Electing up to 80 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional District Republican Convention on Saturday, May 21, 2016. The time and location are to be determined.
- 3. Electing a Unit Chairman;
- 4. For the transactions of such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.

Qualifications for Participation:

All legal and qualified voters under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting, either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Members of the Virginia National Guard, the United States Armed Forces, Merchant Marine, or Coast Guard who are serving on active duty who comply with these filing requirements shall not be required to be elected, but shall be declared a delegate pursuant to Article VIII, Section H, Paragraph 6 of the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia.

Filing Requirements:

All candidates for offices to be elected at the Mass Meeting shall file a written statement which must be turned in at the Mass Meeting on

March 23, 2016. The location for the meeting will be at the Williamsburg Regional Library, Room B, 515 Scotland Street, Williamsburg, VA at 7 pm.

There is no fee to attend the Mass Meeting and no fee to be a delegate or alternate to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional District Convention; however, a \$35.00 voluntary fee payable to the “Republican Party of Virginia” is appreciated to help defray the cost of the State Convention.
