OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting
of the James City County Republican Committee
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the James City County Committee of the Republican Party (JCCRC) and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Amanda E. Johnston, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at 4301 New Town Ave, Williamsburg, VA 23188 beginning at 7:00 p.m. EST on Wednesday, March 23, 2016. Registration begins at 5:30 p.m. EST. The primary purpose of the Mass Meeting is:

1. Electing up to 730 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia's Quadrennial Convention, commencing at 2:30 p.m. EDT on April 29, 2016, and ending April 30, 2016, at the Convocation Center of James Madison University located at 895 University Boulevard, Harrisonburg, VA 22807 or its alternate site. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the James City County Republican Committee is entitled to 146 Delegate Votes;
2. Elect Delegates and Alternates to the 1st Congressional District Republican Convention commencing at 4:30 pm. EST on Saturday, May 7, 2016, at James Monroe High School, 2300 Washington Ave, Fredericksburg, VA 22401 or its alternate site. The number of delegates is to be determined.
3. Elect Delegates and Alternates to the 2nd Congressional District Republican Convention. The date, location, and number of delegates is to be determined.
4. Electing a Unit Chairman;
5. Electing members of the James City County Republican Committee Unit;
6. For the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

All legal and qualified voters under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting, either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Members of the Virginia National Guard, the United States Armed Forces, Merchant Marine, or Coast Guard who are serving on active duty who comply with these filing requirements shall not be required to be elected, but shall be declared a delegate pursuant to Article VIII, Section H. Paragraph 6 of the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia.

PUBLICATION

By a two-thirds vote, the James City County Republican City Committee waived the requirement that this Call be published in a newspaper of general circulation. It shall be published on the websites of the Republican Party of Virginia (www.virginia.gov) and the James City County Republican Committee (www.jccrc.org).

FILING REQUIREMENTS

All candidates for offices to be elected at the Mass Meeting shall file a written statement by mail to Chairman Amanda E. Johnston, P.O. Box 2104, Williamsburg, VA, 23187 or in person to 3633 Marlbrook Drive, Toano, VA 23168, which must be received not later than 5:00 p.m. on March 16, 2016, and accompanied by any fees as noted below. Postmarks shall not govern. An official filing form may be found at www.jccrc.org or by emailing JCCRepublicanCommittee@gmail.com or calling 757-903-6311. If no more than one candidate properly files for election to any office to be voted upon at the Mass Meeting, that candidate will be declared elected. If fewer than the maximum number of Delegates to which James City County is entitled at any convention properly file, all properly prefiled candidates shall be deemed elected. If the number of candidates who file for all offices to be voted upon at the Mass Meeting does not exceed the number to be elected, respectively, then no mass meeting will be held.

PREFILING/REGISTRATION FEES

Unit Chairman - \$ 150.00 Prefiling fee (mandatory)

JCCRC member - \$ 30.00 annual dues, first year to be paid at prefiling (mandatory)

Delegate/Alternate Delegate to the Republican Party of Virginia Convention - \$35.00 registration fee (voluntary)

Delegate/Alternate Delegate to the 1st Congressional District Republican Convention - \$5.00 registration fee (voluntary)

There will be a registration fee of \$10.00 (voluntary) to participate in this mass meeting.
