

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting
of Portsmouth Republican Party (PRV)
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the PRP of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Lawton Baker, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Portsmouth City Council Chambers, 801 Crawford Street, 6th floor, Portsmouth, Virginia 23704, registration starts at 6 PM and the meeting starts at 7 PM local time on March 14th, 2016 for the purpose of:

1. Electing a Unit Chair and members of the Portsmouth Republican Party. Any person seeking election as Unit Chair must declare his/her intention in writing, with a \$250.00 (two-hundred and fifty dollars) fee and file both requirements with Joy Dean, 4418 N. Highgate Circle, Portsmouth, Virginia 23703 by 5:00pm on March 1, 2016. Postmark does not govern.
2. Electing Delegates to the 3rd Congressional District convention to be held at Fraternal Order of Police, Tower Auditorium, 4040 McLean Street, Portsmouth, Va. 23701 on May 7th, 2016, registration beginning at 10:00am, Convention call to order at 11:00am. For the purposes of Electing a Republican 3rd District Chairman, electing 3 Representatives to the State Central Committee, electing 3 delegates and 3 alternates to the Republican National Convention, Nominate one elector from the 3rd Congressional District of Virginia, and transaction any other business that may properly come before the Convention. Portsmouth is allocated 79 Delegate Votes, with full voting strength of 598. The time and location are subject to change.
3. Electing delegates to the Virginia Republican State Convention to be held on April 29th at 2:30pm and April 30th, at 12:00pm local time. James Madison University Convocation Center, 895 University Blvd, Harrisonburg, Virginia 22807. Portsmouth is allocated 79 Delegates.
4. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of The City of Portsmouth under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. Voters may be required to produce personal identification such as a valid driver's license or voter registration card. Attendance is required to vote.

Registration Fee

There will be **no** mandatory registration fee to participate in this mass meeting. A **voluntary** \$10.00 fee will be requested in order to fund the costs of the Mass meeting.
