

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting of the Prince George County Republican Committee (PGCRC)
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the PGCRC of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Wayne Cunningham, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Human Services, Bldg. #12, 6450 Administration Drive, 1st Floor, Prince George, VA 23875. Registration starts at 6:00 p.m. local time and the meeting starts at 7:00 p.m. local time on March 24, 2016 for the purpose of:

- A. Electing a Unit Chair for the Prince George County Republican Committee.
A mandatory filing fee of \$30 is required and payable to PGCRC.
- B. Electing the members of the Prince George County Republican Committee.
- C. Electing Delegates and Alternates to the 4th Congressional District convention to be held on May 21, 2016 starting at 10:00 A.M. at Airfield Conference Center, 15189 Airfield Road, Wakefield, VA 23888 for the purposes of electing (i) a Republican 4th Congressional District Chairman, (ii) Electing three members to the State Central Committee from the 4th Congressional District, (iii) Electing three Delegates and three Alternate Delegates (“National Delegates”) to the Republican National Convention, (iv) Nominating one Elector from the Fourth Congressional District to be voted for in the presidential election on November 8, 2016 and (v) Transaction of any other business that may duly come before the Convention. Prince George is allocated 56 Delegate Votes, with full voting strength of 280. A voluntary fee of \$10 is requested of each Delegate and Alternate
- D. Electing Delegates and Alternates to the Virginia Republican Convention to be held at the James Madison University Convocation Center on April 29-30, 2016 for the following purposes:
 - (i) Electing 13 At-Large Delegates (“National Delegates”) and 13 At-Large Alternate Delegates (“National Alternates”) to the Republican National Convention to be held on July 18-21, 2016, at the Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland, Ohio (or its alternate site) (the “National Convention”);
 - (ii) Nominating two Elector At-Large to be voted for in the presidential election on November 8, 2016;
 - (iii) Electing a State Chairman;
 - (iv) Electing a National Committeeman and National Committeewoman;
 - (v) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention. The Convention will open on April 29 at 2:30 pm for the election of permanent Convention officers and adoption of rules.
 - (vi) No other election shall occur prior to 1:30 pm on April 30.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Prince George County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. Voters may be required to produce personal identification such as a valid driver's license or voter registration card. **Attendance is required.**

Filing Requirements

- A. Candidates for election as Unit Chairman of the PGCRC shall complete a pre-file form. A mandatory filing fee of \$30 is required and payable to PGCRC.
- B. Candidates for election as Committee Members shall complete a pre-file Membership Form and their annual dues (\$25-individual, \$30-couple, \$10-full- time student) payable to PGCRC.
- C. Candidates for election as the 4th Congressional District and/or RPV State Convention Delegates/Alternates shall file a pre-file form and their voluntary convention fee(s) (\$10 for 4th District, \$35 for RPV) payable to PGCRC.
- D. The information and fees required in the above paragraphs shall be received by PGCRC Treasurer, Barbara Tabb, at 10457 Jordan Parkway, North Prince George, VA 23860, by 5:00 P.M. by March 18, 2016. Postmark does not govern.
- E. If any pre-filed Delegate/Alternate is not chosen to serve as Delegate/Alternate fees will be deemed as a donation to PGCRC.

Registration Fee

There is a voluntary registration fee to participate in this mass meeting of \$10.00 to fund the costs of the Mass meeting.

Revisions

In the event that the Call requires technical or conforming changes, the Unit Chair of the PGCRC is authorized to revise the Call to make any such technical changes. The Unit Chair shall promptly notify the Committee Members of any such technical changes.
