As Chairman of the Charlotte County Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Peggy Armentrout, do hereby issue this Call for a Mass Meeting to be held:

Mass Meeting Purposes:

A. Electing up to 110 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia's State Convention, to be held April 29-30, 2016 James Madison Convocation Center, Harrisonburg, VA. Charlotte County is entitled to 22 Delegate Votes.

B. Electing up to 110 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 5th Congressional District Republican Convention, to be held on Saturday, May 14, 2016 at the Nelson County High School, Lovingston, VA or an alternate site if necessary. Charlotte County is entitled to 22 Delegate Votes.

C. Election of Charlotte County Republican Committee Unit Officers as follows: Chairman, Vice-Chair Secretary and Treasurer.

D. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.

All legal and qualified voters of Charlotte County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. Please be advised proxies are not allowed at mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries per RNC rules. Registration for the Mass Meeting will be closed at 7:00 pm to all except individuals already in line.

State and 5th District Convention Delegate Filing Requirements

Delegate candidates for election at said Mass Meeting shall file a separate application for each Convention beginning February 12, 2016 and ending March 3, 2016 at 7:00 PM. Each respective application is attached to this call and each is also available at rpv.org. Completed applications are to be mailed or delivered to Peggy Armentrout, Chairman, 1645 George Washington Hwy, Charlotte Courthouse, VA 23923 or to Charlotte County Republican Committee, PO Box 264, Charlotte Courthouse, VA 23923. Postmarks do not govern and it is the responsibility of the delegate to confirm receipt of application with the Chair. Delegate candidates may also attend the Mass Meeting to file in person. Emailed applications will not be accepted.

Charlotte County Republican Committee Unit Officers Filing Requirements

Candidates for election or nomination at said Mass Meeting shall file a written statement declaring intent to run for a specific office by mail to Peggy Armentrout, Chairman 1645 George Washington Hwy, Charlotte Courthouse, VA 23923 or to Charlotte County Republican Committee, PO Box 264, Charlotte Courthouse, VA 23923 which must be received not later than 7:00 pm on March 3, 2016. It is the responsibility of the candidate to confirm receipt of the declaration with Chairman. Emailed statements will not be accepted.

Registration Fees

The Republican Party of Virginia is requesting a voluntary \$35 filing fee from all individuals seeking election as a Delegate to the State Convention. Checks need to be made out to the "Republican Party of Virginia". The Republican Committee of the 5th Congressional District is requesting a voluntary \$25 filing fee from all individuals seeking election as a Delegate to the 5th Congressional District Convention. Checks need to be made out to the "Charlotte County Republican Committee".
