

OFFICIAL CALL

Mass Meeting of the CARROLL COUNTY REPUBLICAN COMMITTEE

Of the REPUBLICAN PARTY OF VIRGINIA

As Chairman of the **Carroll County Republican Committee**, and Pursuant to the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Joshua A. Hendrick, do hereby issue this **call for a Mass Meeting**, to be held at the **Carroll County Governmental Center, Board of Supervisors Meeting Room, Second Floor, starting at 7:00 P.M. local time on Monday, March 7, 2016** for the following purposes:

1. Electing a unit chairman, vice chairman, treasurer, secretary, parliamentarian, and three (3) committee seats per magisterial district.
2. Electing up to (275) Delegates and equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia 9th Congressional District Convention to be held at George Wythe High School, #1 Maroon Way, Wytheville VA 24382 on Saturday, April 9th, 2016, Registration starting at 8:00AM and Convening at 10:00AM for the following purposes:
 - a. Electing a District Chairman of the Ninth Congressional District Republican Committee
 - b. Electing three (3) members of the State Central Committee
 - c. Electing three (3) delegates and (3) alternate delegates to the 2016 Republican National Convention to be held at the Quicken Loans Arena, in Cleveland, Ohio, or its alternate site, from July 18-21, 2016
 - d. Nominating one (1) Elector from the Ninth Congressional District of Virginia to serve in the 2016 Electoral College
 - e. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the convention

Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Carroll County is entitled to (55) Delegate Votes at the District Convention.

3. Electing up to (275) Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention to be held on Friday/Saturday, April 29-30, 2016 at James Madison University Convocation Center, 895 University Blvd. Harrisonburg, VA 22807 at 10:00AM local time for the following purposes:
 - a. Electing 13 at-large delegates (“National Delegates”) and 13 at-large alternate delegates (“National Alternates”) to the Republican National Convention to be held on July 18-21, 2016 at the Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland, Ohio (or its alternate site) (the “National Convention)
 - b. Nominating two Electors At-Large to be voted for in the presidential election on November 8, 2016
 - c. Electing a State Chairman

- d. Electing a Nation Committeeman and National Committeewoman;
- e. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the convention.

Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Carroll County is entitled to (55) Delegate Votes at the State Convention.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

All legal and qualified voters of Carroll County, under the laws of the commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin, or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all if its nominees for public office in the upcoming election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party in the last five years. A single exception to the above shall be approved for a voter renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. A voter that utilizes the foregoing exception as identified in this paragraph thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party shall not have the benefit of this exception thereafter.

FILING REQUIREMENTS

Officers for the Carroll County Republican Committee are presented by the Nominating Committee to be voted on at the Carroll County Republican Committee Mass Meeting. Pre-filing for potential delegates is not required.

There is no voluntary registration fee for participation in the Carroll County Republican Mass Meeting.

There is a voluntary registration fee of \$35.00 to participate in the Republican State Convention and a \$10.00 voluntary registration fee to participate in the 9th District Convention.
