

**OFFICIAL CALL**  
**For a**  
**Mass Meeting of the Charles City Republican Committee**  
**of the Republican Party of Virginia**

As Chairman of the Charles City Republican Committee, (CCCRC) of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Connie Warner, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Fire Station 3, 14330 Wilcox Neck Rd. Charles City, VA 23030. Registration begins at 6:30 p.m. local time and the meeting starts at 7:00 p.m. on April 5, 2016 for the following purposes:

A. Electing a Unit Chairman for the Charles City Republican Committee.

B. Electing the Members for the Charles City Republican Committee.

C. Electing Delegates and Alternates to the 4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District convention to be held at the Airfield Conference Center, 15189 Airfield Road, Wakefield, VA 23888, starting at 10:00 a.m. local time, May 21, 2016 for the following purposes:

- (i) Electing a 4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District Committee Chairman;
- (ii) Electing three members to the State Central Committee from the 4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District;
- (iii) Electing three Delegates and three Alternate Delegates (“National Delegates”) to the Republican National Convention;
- (iv) Nominating one Elector from the 4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District to be voted for in the presidential election on November 8, 2016 and
- (v) Transaction of any other business that may duly come before the Convention.

The County of Charles City is allocated 9 Delegate Votes with full voting strength of 45.

D. Electing Delegates and Alternates to the Virginia Republican Convention to be held at the James Madison University Convocation Center on April 29-30, 2016 for the following purposes:

- (i) Electing 13 At-Large Delegates (“National Delegates”) and 13 At-Large Alternate Delegates (“National Alternates”) to the Republican National Convention to be held on July 18-21, 2016 at the Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland, Ohio (or its alternate site) (the “National Convention”);
- (ii) Nominating two Electors At-Large to be voted for in the presidential election on November 8, 2016;
- (iii) Electing a State Chairman;
- (iv) Electing a National Committeeman and National Committeewoman;
- (v) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention. The Convention will open on April 29 at 2:30 p.m. for the election of permanent Convention officers and adoption of rules.
- (vi) No other election shall occur prior to 1:30 pm on April 30.

### **Qualifications for Participation**

All legal and qualified voters of Charles City County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in an open meeting, either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. Voters will be required to produce personal identification, such as a valid driver's license and/or voter registration card.

If the number of persons pre-filing as candidates for election or nominations for all offices to be decided upon by and Mass Meeting does not exceed the number to be elected or nominated, then the candidates may be declared elected or nominated by the Republican Party and the Mass Meeting may be cancelled as provided for in this call.

### **Filing Requirements**

A. Candidates for election as Unit Chairman of the CCCRC shall complete a pre-file form. A mandatory filing fee of \$10 is required payable to the CCCRC.

B. Candidates for election as Committee Members shall complete a pre-file membership form and their annual dues of \$15 payable to CCCRC.

C. Candidates for election as the 4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District and/or RPV Convention Delegates/Alternates shall file a pre-file form and their voluntary convention fee(s) (\$10 for 4<sup>th</sup> District, \$35 for RPV) payable to CCCRC.

D. The information and fees required in the above paragraphs shall be received by CCCRC member, Peter Churins, 18700 Tettington Ln., Charles City, VA 23030 by 6:30 p.m. on March 29, 2016. Postmark does not govern. All fees are to be made payable to Charles City Republican Committee.

E. If any pre-filed Delegate/Alternate is not chosen to serve as Delegate/Alternate fees will be deemed as a donation to CCCRC/RPV.

### **Registration Fee**

There is a voluntary \$10 registration fee to participate in the CCCRC Mass Meeting to fund the costs of the Mass Meeting.

### **Revisions**

In the event that the Call requires technical or conforming changes, the Unit Chair of the CCCRC is authorized to revise the Call to make any such technical changes. The Unit Chair shall promptly notify the Committee Members of any such technical changes.
