



OFFICIAL CALL

Mass Meeting of the King George Republican Committee Of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the King George Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Ray Duncan do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Tabernacle Baptist Church, 10640 Kings Hwy, King George, VA 22485, on March 17, 2016 (check in to begin at 6:30 PM) starting at 7:00 PM for the following purposes:

1. Electing a Unit Chairman;
2. Electing members of the Unit Committee;
3. Electing up to 210 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia's 1st Congressional District Convention to be held at the James Monroe High School, 2300 Washington Ave, Fredericksburg, VA 22401 or its alternate site, starting Saturday, May 7th at 4:30 p.m. with registration beginning at 2 p.m. for the following purposes:
 - (A) Electing a 1st District Chairman
 - (B) Electing three members to the Republican Party State Central Committee
 - (C) Electing three National Delegates, and three National Alternates to the National Convention
 - (D) Electing one Elector to be voted for in the Presidential Election on Nov 8, 2016
 - (E) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the 1st District convention;
4. Electing up to 210 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention to be held on Saturday, April 30, 2016 at the James Madison Convention Center, 895 University Blvd, Harrisonburg, Virginia 22807 or its alternate site, beginning at 12:00 noon. local time for the following purposes:
 - (A) Electing 13 At-Large Delegates ("National Delegates") and 13 At-Large Alternate Delegates ("National Alternates") to the Republican National Convention to be held July 18-21 at the Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland Ohio (or its alternate site)
 - (B) Nominating two Electors At-Large to be voted for in the presidential election on November 8, 2016
 - (C) Electing a State Chairman
 - (D) Electing a National Committeeman and National Committeewoman

(E) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come the State Convention;

5. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

For the State Convention, each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes cast or major portion thereof for the Republican candidate in the most recent elections for President and Governor, so that King George County is entitled to forty-two (42) Delegate Votes;

For the District Convention, each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes cast or major portion thereof for the Republican candidate in the most recent elections for President and Governor, so that King George County is entitled to forty-two (42) Delegate Votes;

I. Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of King George County, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party in the last five years.

A single exception to the above shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. A voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a Party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception as identified in this paragraph thereafter. In order to be eligible for election as a Delegate or Alternate Delegate to any convention, an individual must be registered to vote no later than the pre-filing deadline established by the Official Committee. A person who has made application for registration and meets all other requirements herein, but whose name does not appear on the local registration books solely because of the books having been closed in connection with a local election, will nevertheless be deemed a legal and qualified voter.

II. Filing Requirements

- a) Candidates for the election of a unit chairman shall file the form attached to this Call, with a registration fee of \$500.00 (non-refundable and payable to the King George Committee) to KGRC, PO Box 221, King George, VA 22485 or in person to any Officer of the King George Republican Committee and must be received not later than March 4, 2016 at 4:00 PM. Postmarks do not govern. If only one candidate properly files, then said candidate shall be declared the chairman.
- b) Candidates for the election to unit member shall file the form attached to this Call, with biannual dues of \$40.00 (non-refundable and payable to the King George Committee) to KGRC, PO Box 221, King George, VA 22485 or in person to any Officer of the King George Republican Committee and must be received not later than March 4, 2016 at 4:00 PM. Postmarks do not govern.
- c) Candidates for election to the Delegate (or Alternate) to the May 7th 1st District Convention and/or Delegate (or Alternate) to the April 30 State Convention must submit the filing form attached to this call, which states intent to seek election for each specific position and which will include name, address, phone number and e-mail and voluntary fee (if applicable) to KGRC, PO Box 221, King George, VA 22485 or in person to any Officer of the King George Republican Committee and must be received not later than March 4, 2016 at 4:00 PM. Postmarks do not govern.
- d) Any resolutions to be considered by the mass meeting shall be detailed on the form attached to this Call and submitted to KGRC, PO Box 221, King George, VA 22485 or in person to any Officer of the King George Republican Committee and must be received not later than March 4, 2016 at 4:00 PM. Postmarks do not govern.

No nominations will be accepted from the floor.
No resolutions will be accepted from the floor.

- III. No "Slating". With the exception where a unit has more qualified State, District or Legislative District Convention delegate candidates than may be elected ("Overfiles"), all delegate candidates who met the requirements of Article I and, where required, any prefiling requirements, shall be deemed elected unless there are individual votes on each candidate not to be elected. In the event of Overfiles, a unit shall elect not less than the total number of delegates allowed under the Plan unless there are individual votes on each candidate not to be elected. In the event of Overfiles, in no event shall delegate candidates who have not paid the requested filing fee be elected unless all delegate candidates who have paid

the fee and who are qualified under Article I of the Party Plan shall have been elected first.

IV. There will be no proxy voting at the Mass Meeting.

V. Registration and Fees

There will be no fee to participate in this mass meeting. There is a voluntary registration fee of \$35.00 to participate in the Republican State Convention and a \$10.00 voluntary registration fee to participate in the 1st District Convention.

I hereby file my candidacy for Membership to the King George County Republican Committee. Attached is a check for biannual dues of \$40.00 for the year 2016 – 2017 term.

I hereby seek election as a Delegate representing King George County at the 1st Congressional District Convention to be held on Saturday, May, 7, 2016 at James Monroe High School, 2300 Washington Ave., Fredericksburg, VA, 22401. (A voluntary fee of \$10 is requested.)

I hereby seek election as a Delegate representing King George County at the 2016 Republican State Convention to be held on April 30, 2016 at the James Madison Convention Center 895 University Blvd., Harrisonburg, VA, 22807. (A voluntary fee of \$35 is requested.)

I request the resolution(s) on an attached sheet be considered by the Mass Meeting Resolution Committee for presentation to the Mass Meeting.

Paragraph 1, Article I of the Republican Party of Virginia State Party Plan states the following – All legal and qualified voters under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions, or primaries encompassing their respective election districts

Paragraph 2, Article I – A voter who, subsequent to making a statement of intent, publicly supports a candidate in opposition to a Republican nominee shall not be qualified for participation in party actions as defined in Article I for a period of four years.

Paragraph 4, Article I – In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party with in the last five years

Paragraph 5 Article I – A single exception to Paragraph 4 shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception identified in this paragraph thereafter. Within 30 days of receipt, the Official Committee shall provide a copy of this signed renunciation statement to the Republican Party of Virginia, to be maintained for a period of 5 years.

Article VII, Section C of the Republican Party Plan of Organization states the following about membership on a county committee: A member of an Official Committee is held to a higher standard of support for nominees of the Republican Party than an individual who merely participates in a mass meeting, party canvass, convention or primary. Therefore, a member of an Official Committee is deemed to have resigned his Committee position if he (a) makes a reportable contribution to and/or (b) allows his name to be publicly used by and/or (c) makes a written or other public statement in support of a candidate in opposition to a Republican nominee in a Virginia General or Special Election.

By signing this form, I certify that I am a registered voter in King George County, have read and understand the requirements above and that I intend to support all nominees of the Republican Party during this election (for convention delegates) and/or during my two-year term as a member of the King George County Republican Committee.
