

OFFICIAL CALL  
**Mass Meeting**  
of the Chesapeake City Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Chesapeake City Committee of the Republican Party (the City Committee), and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the City Committee, I, Walton P. Burkheimer, Jr., do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at **Deep Creek High School**, 2900 Margaret Booker Drive, Chesapeake, VA 23323, starting at **10:00 a.m.** local time (with registration starting at 9:00 a.m.) on **Saturday, March 26, 2016** for the following purposes:

1. Electing a Chairman for the Chesapeake City Committee.
2. Electing the Members of the Chesapeake City Committee.
3. Electing up to 1,655 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates, to cast 331 Delegate votes, to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention, to be held on Saturday, April 30, 2016 at the James Madison University Convocation Center, 895 University Boulevard, Harrisonburg, VA 22807, or its alternate site, beginning at noon, for the following purposes:
  - a. Electing 13 At-Large Delegates (“National Delegates”) and 13 At-Large Alternate Delegates (“National Alternates”) to the Republican National Convention to be held on July 18-21, 2016, at the Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland, Ohio (or its alternate site) (the “National Convention”);
  - b. Nominating two Electors At-Large to be voted for in the presidential election on November 8, 2016;
  - c. Electing a State Chairman;
  - d. Electing a National Committeeman and National Committeewoman;
  - e. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention.
4. Electing up to 570 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates, to cast 114 Delegate votes, to the Republican Party of Virginia Third Congressional District Convention, to be held on Saturday, May 7, 2016 at Fraternal Order of Police, Tower Auditorium, 4040 McLean Street, Portsmouth, VA 23701, or at its alternate site, beginning at 10 a.m. for the following purposes:
  - a. Electing a Chairman for the Third Congressional District Republican Committee.
  - b. Electing three members of the State Central Committee.
  - c. Electing three Delegates and three Alternate Delegates (“National Alternates”) to the Republican National Convention to be held on July 18-21, 2016, at the Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland, Ohio (or its alternate site) (the “National Convention”);
  - d. Nominating one Elector from the Third Congressional District to be voted for in the presidential election on November 8, 2016;
  - e. Nominating a Candidate for the office of Congressman from the Third Congressional District;
  - f. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention.

5. Electing up to 1,085 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates, to cast 217 Delegate votes, to the Republican Party of Virginia Fourth Congressional District Convention, to be held on Saturday, May 21, 2016 at the Airfield Conference Center, 15189 Airfield Road, Wakefield, VA 23888, or at its alternate site, beginning at 10 a.m. for the following purposes:
  - a. Electing a Chairman for the Fourth Congressional District Republican Committee.
  - b. Electing three members of the State Central Committee.

- c. Electing three Delegates and three Alternate Delegates (“National Alternates”) to the Republican National Convention to be held on July 18-21, 2016, at the Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland, Ohio (or its alternate site) (the “National Convention”);
- d. Nominating one Elector from the Fourth Congressional District to be voted for in the presidential election on November 8, 2016;
- e. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention.

- 6. Rallying in support of the City Committee’s endorsed candidates for Chesapeake Mayor, Chesapeake City Council and Chesapeake School Board.
- 7. Such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.

#### Qualifications for Participation

All voters of the City of Chesapeake, Virginia, legal and qualified under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees and/or endorsees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its Mass Meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

#### Filing Requirements, Candidates for Chairman and for Delegate to the Convention(s)

Candidates for Delegate or Alternate to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention and/or the District Republican Convention for the Congressional District in which they reside shall return their properly completed and signed “2016 District and State Convention Delegate Filing Form” to Mr. Adam Perry, Corresponding Secretary of the City Committee, 1500 Hambleton Loop, Chesapeake, VA 23320, so as to be received by Mr. Perry not later than 7:00 p.m. local time on Friday, March 11, 2016. Postmarks shall not govern.

If, for any Convention, fewer candidates than the maximum numbers set forth above are properly filed, all will be deemed elected Delegates to the Convention(s), and the election of Delegates to the Convention(s) shall be deleted from the agenda of the Mass Meeting. However, in any case, the Mass Meeting will not be canceled.

Candidates for Chesapeake City Committee Chairman shall return a letter expressing their candidacy to Mr. Perry at the address, and to be received by the same date and time set forth above.

Any Military Member who is otherwise qualified to participate in Republican Party actions and who has filed the required form and produced at the time of filing valid military identification or other proof of active-duty status, shall be certified as a delegate to the convention(s) filed for, and shall not be required to be elected as a delegate.

#### Mass Meeting Registration

Registration to participate in the Mass Meeting may be prepared in advance and mailed to Mr. Perry at the address above, using the “2016 Mass Meeting Registration Form,” or may be accomplished immediately prior to the Mass Meeting itself, beginning at 9:00 a.m. However, filing for candidacy for election as a delegate or alternate to either convention, although using the same form, MUST be received by Mr. Perry by Friday, March 11, 2016 as provided above.

There will be no mandatory registration fee to participate in this Mass Meeting, nor any mandatory filing fee for either Convention. The following **voluntary** fees are requested to help defray the costs of conducting the Mass Meeting and Conventions: Chesapeake Mass Meeting, \$10.00; 3<sup>rd</sup> District Convention, \$10.00 4<sup>th</sup> District Convention, \$25.00; State Convention, \$35.00. Make separate checks for each meeting/convention to **RPC, Third VA Congressional District Committee, Fourth VA Congressional District Republican Committee**, and/or **RPV**, as applicable.
