

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting of Richmond City Committee
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Richmond City Republican Committee, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Davis Rennolds, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at The American Legion Department of Virginia, 1708 Commonwealth Avenue Richmond, VA 23230, starting at 6:30pm local time on March 22nd 2016 for the following purposes:

A) Electing a Unit Chairman

B) Electing members of the Unit Committee

C) Electing up to 600 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to cast 120 delegate votes at the 4th District Republican Convention to be held on May 21st at The Airfield Conference Center, 15189 Airfield Road, Wakefield, VA 23888, starting at 10:00 A.M. The purposes of the 4th District Convention are: to elect a District Chair and three members to the Republican State Central Committee; to elect three delegates and three alternate delegates to the Republican National Convention; and to nominate one candidate for Presidential Elector. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the Richmond GOP is entitled to 120 Delegate Votes.

D) Electing up to 600 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to cast 120 delegate votes at the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention to be held on April 29-30, 2016 at James Madison University in Harrisonburg Virginia. The purposes of the State Convention are: to elect a State Chairman, National Committeeman and National Committeewoman; to elect 13 delegates and 13 alternate delegates to the Republican National Convention, and to nominate two candidates for Presidential Elector at-large. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the Richmond GOP is entitled to 120 Delegate Votes.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of the City of Richmond under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for member of the Richmond City Republican Committee, or Delegate to any convention must prefile using the form available with this call on the Republican Party of Virginia website, www.virginia.gop, the Richmond City GOP Website, www.rvagop.org. Completed forms, along with a check for applicable filing fees, must be received by Jason De La Cruz, Secretary RVA GOP 1007 Granite Ave, Richmond, VA 23226 not later than 5pm Monday March 21st 2016. Postmarks shall not govern.

Candidates for election as Unit Chair of the Richmond City Republican Committee must prefile using the form available with this call on the Republican Party of Virginia website, www.virginia.gop, the Richmond City GOP Website, www.rvagop.org. Completed forms, along with a check for applicable filing fees, must be received by Jason De La Cruz, Secretary RVA GOP 1007 Granite Ave, Richmond, VA 23226 not later than 5pm Thursday March 10th 2016. Postmarks shall not govern.

Filing Fees:

Candidate for Unit Chair - \$100.00 (required)
Member, Richmond City Republican Committee - \$30.00 (required)
Delegate, RPV State Convention - \$35.00 (voluntary)
Delegate, 4th District Convention - \$25.00 (voluntary)

Checks should be made payable to Republican Party of the City of Richmond and must accompany the prefiling form.

A voluntary donation of \$15.00 is requested for the mass meeting, and may accompany the prefiling or be paid at the door. If the mass meeting is canceled, the \$15.00 donation will be refunded.

If the number of persons prefilling as candidates for election to any office by this Mass Meeting does not exceed the number that can be elected, all duly prefiled candidates qualified under Article I of the State Party Plan shall be declared elected. If the number of qualified persons prefilling as candidates for election for all offices to be decided upon by the Mass Meeting does not exceed the number that can be elected, then the candidates shall be declared elected and the Mass Meeting shall be cancelled
