

OFFICIAL MASS MEETING CALL FOR THE RADFORD CITY REPUBLICAN COMMITTEE

As Chairman of the Radford City Unit Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Alex Owen Davis, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held on Tuesday, February 23, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Radford Courthouse, General District Courtroom, 619 Second Street, Radford, VA (or an alternate site, depending on weather and/or availability) for the following purposes:

1. Electing an Executive Committee comprised of a Unit Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, and Treasurer
2. Electing members of the Unit Committee
3. Electing up to 80 delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 9th Congressional District Republican Convention, to be held on Saturday, 09 April 2016 at the George Wythe High School, 1 Maroon Way, Wytheville, VA 24382 or its alternative site, beginning at 10:00AM EDT for the following purposes:
 - a. Electing a 9th Congressional District Republican Committee Chairman;
 - b. Electing delegates and alternates to the Republican National Convention in Cleveland, 18-21 July 2016;
 - c. Electing a presidential elector for the 9th Congressional District Republican Committee;
 - d. Electing RPV State Committee Members representing the 9th Congressional District Republican Committee;
 - e. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the convention;
4. Electing up to 80 delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia Convention, to be held on 29-30 April 2016 at the James Madison Convocation Center, 895 University Blvd, Harrisonburg, VA 22807 or its alternative site, beginning at 2:30PM EDT on 29 April, and 12:00PM on 30 April, for the following purposes:
 - a. Electing a Republican Party of Virginia Chairman;
 - b. Electing delegates and alternates to the Republican National Convention in Cleveland, 18-21 July 2016;
 - c. Electing presidential electors for the Republican Party of Virginia;
 - d. Electing a Committeeman and Committeewoman to the Republican National Committee;
 - e. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the convention.
5. And for the transaction of such business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of the City of Radford under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles

of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. Voters may be required to produce personal identification such as a valid driver's license or voter registration card in order to participate in the mass meeting or convention.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for the election or nomination at said mass meeting for:

1. Chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer, and Secretary of the Radford Republican Committee;
2. Members of the Unit Committee
3. Delegate and Alternate to the 9th Congressional District Convention on 09 April 2016;
4. Delegate and Alternate to the Republican Party of Virginia Convention on 29-30 April 2016;

Shall file a **signed** pre-file form by mail, in electronic form, or in person, to Alex Owen Davis, 1200 Grove Avenue, Radford, VA 24141 which must be received not later than 9:00PM EST on Saturday, February 20, 2016. (Postmarks do not govern) Forms can be obtained at:
