## OFFICIAL CALL

### **Mass Meeting of Roanoke City Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia**

As Chairman of the Roanoke City Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, John Brill, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Holiday Inn at 3315 Ordway Dr NW, Roanoke, VA 24017, starting at 6:30 PM local time (doors will open at 6:00 PM) on February 25, 2016, for the following purposes:

1. Electing a Chairman for the Roanoke City Republican Committee
2. Electing the members of the Roanoke City Republican Committee
3. Electing one nominee for Mayor
4. Electing three nominees for Roanoke City Council
5. Electing up to 455 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention, to be held on April 30, 2016 at James Madison University Convocation Center, 895 University Boulevard, Harrisonburg, VA 22807 beginning at 12:00 pm for the purposes of:
  - i. Electing 13 At-Large Delegates (“National Delegates”) and 13 At-Large Alternate Delegates (“National Alternates”) to the Republican National Convention to be held on July 18-21, 2016, at the Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland, Ohio (or its alternate site) (the “National Convention”);
  - ii. Nominating two Electors At-Large to be voted for in the presidential election on November 8, 2016;
  - iii. Electing a State Chairman;
  - iv. Electing a National Committeeman and National Committeewoman;
  - v. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention.Each unit’s maximum number of delegates is a number five (5) times its respective Delegate Vote or 91 for the Roanoke City Republican Committee;

6. Electing up to 455 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 6th District Republican Committee Convention, to be held on May 21, 2016 at Cave Spring High School, 3712 Chaparral Dr, Roanoke, VA 24018 (or its alternate site) beginning at 10am for the purposes of

- i. Electing three (3) National Delegates and three (3) National Alternates from the Sixth Congressional District of Virginia to the Republican National Convention;
- ii. Nominating one (1) Elector from the Sixth Congressional District of Virginia to be voted for in the presidential election on November 8, 2016;
- iii. Electing a Chairman for the Sixth Congressional District of the Virginia Republican Party of Virginia;
- iv. Electing three (3) Regional Vice Chairman for the Sixth Congressional District of the Republican Party of Virginia;
- v. Electing three (3) members to the State Central Committee from the Sixth Congressional District;
- vi. The transaction of such other business that may properly come before the Sixth Congressional District Convention.

Each unit's maximum number of delegates is a number five (5) times its respective Delegate Vote or 91 for the Roanoke City Republican Committee.

5. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

### **Qualifications for Participation**

All legal and qualified voters of Roanoke City under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions, or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party with in the last five years.

A single exception to the above shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican

Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception identified in this paragraph thereafter. Within 30 days of receipt, the Official Committee shall provide a copy of this signed renunciation statement to the Republican Party of Virginia, to be maintained for a period of 5 years.

### **Filing Requirements**

Delegates:

Candidates for election as Delegates (and Alternates) to the May 21st District Convention and/or the April 30th State Convention may notify the Chairman of the Committee of his or her intention by either pre-filing pursuant to the requirements stated herein, or by being present at the Mass Meeting and so stating his or her intention. Candidates who pre-file do not need to be present at the Mass Meeting to be elected as a delegate. Pre-filing forms can be sent by mail to John Brill, Roanoke City Republican Committee, P.O. Box 3318, Roanoke, VA 24015, emailed to John Brill at johnbrillgop@gmail.com, or hand delivered to John Brill, which must be received no later than 5:00PM, February 22nd, 2016. The pre-file form is available at Roanokegop.org. Postmarks do not govern.

City Council and Mayor:

Candidates for election as City Councilman or Mayor at said mass meeting shall file a written statement either by mail or hand delivery to Ben Wisdom, Secretary at either P.O. Box 3318 Roanoke VA 24015 or 1905 Arlington Rd SW Roanoke VA 24015, which must be received not later than 7:00PM on February 18th, 2016. Postmarks will not govern. There will be no nominations from the floor for City Council or Mayor.

Filing shall be in the form of a letter, addressed and presented to Ben Wisdom, Secretary. The letter shall indicate that the candidate seeks the nomination as a Republican Candidate for City Council or Mayor, and shall state that the candidate is a resident of, and registered to vote in Roanoke City, and that he or she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party.

Chairman:

Candidates for election to the position of Chairman of the Roanoke City Republican Committee shall file a written statement of intent either by mail or by hand delivery to Ben Wisdom, Secretary at either P.O. Box 3318 Roanoke VA 24015 or 1905 Arlington Rd SW Roanoke VA 24015, which

must be received not later than 5:00PM on January 19th, 2016. Postmarks will not govern. There will be no nominations from the floor for the office of Chairman.
