

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting of Republican Party of Norfolk
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Republican Party of Norfolk, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Tom Cherry, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Church of the Advent, 9629 Norfolk Ave, Norfolk VA 23503 starting at 10:00 am on March 5, 2016 for the following purposes:

- a) Electing a Unit Chairman.
- b) Electing members of the Unit Committee, the Republican Party of Norfolk.
- c) Electing up to 695 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention, to be held on April 30 2016 at the James Madison University Convocation Center, 895 University Boulevard, Harrisonburg, VA 22807 beginning at 10 a.m. for the purposes of electing a State Party Chairman, RNC National Committeeman, RNC National Committeewoman, 13 At-Large Delegates and 13 At-Large Alternate Delegates to the RNC Convention, and two (2) At-Large Presidential Electors. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the Republican Party of Norfolk is entitled to 139 Delegate Votes;
- d) Electing up to 396 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 2nd District Convention, to be held on May 21, 2016 at [Location TBD] convening at 11:00 am for the purposes of electing a 2nd District Chairman, three (3) Delegates and three (3) Alternate Delegates to the RNC Convention and one (1) Presidential Elector. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Republican Party of Norfolk is entitled to 79 Delegate Votes;
- e) Electing up to 305 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 3rd District Convention, to be held on May 7, 2016 at The Fraternal Order of Police Tower Auditorium, 4040 McLean St. Portsmouth, VA 23701 convening at 11:00 am for the purposes of electing a District Chairman, three (3) Delegates and three (3) Alternate Delegates to the RNC Convention, and one (1) Presidential Elector. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the Republican Party of Norfolk is entitled to 61 Delegate Votes;

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of City of Norfolk under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Filing Requirements Pre-filing, as a candidate for delegate, is required for the Mass Meeting no later than Saturday, February 20th at 5:00 pm. If running for Chairman of the Republican Party of Norfolk, a \$100.00 filing fee is required along with the same filing form by February 20, 2016 5:00 pm to Chairman
