

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting of King and Queen Republican
Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the King and Queen Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, William H. Rilee, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Nick's Restaurant, 3483 Lewis Puller Memorial Highway, Shackelfords, Virginia 23156, on April 5, 2016 with check in to begin at 6:30pm and starting at 7pm local time for the following purposes:

1. Electing a Unit Chair

2. Electing up to 12 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia's 1st Congressional District Convention to be held at the James Monroe High School, 2300 Washington Ave., Fredricksburg, Virginia 22401 or its alternate site, starting Saturday, May 7th 2016 at 4:30 pm with registration beginning at 2pm for the following purposes:

(a) Electing a 1st District Chair

(b) Electing three members to the Republican Party State

Central Committee

(c) Electing three National Delegates, and three National Alternates to the National Convention

(d) Electing one Elector to be voted for in the Presidential Election on November 8, 2016

(e) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the 1st District Convention

3. Electing up to 12 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention to be held on Saturday April 30, 2016 at the James Madison Convention Center, 895 University Blvd, Harrisonburg, Virginia 22807 or its alternate site, beginning at 12:00 noon local time for the following purposes:

(a) Nominating 13 at-large Delegates (“National Delegates”) and 13 At-Large

Alternate Delegates (“National Alternate”) to the Republican National convention to be held July 18-21, 2016 at the Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland, Ohio (or its alternate site)

(b) Nominate two Electors At-Large to be voted for in the Presidential election on November 8, 2016

(c) Electing a State Chair

(d) Electing a National Committeeman and a National Committeewoman

(e) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the State Convention

For the State Convention, each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 240 Republican votes cast or major portion thereof for the Republican candidate in the most recent elections for President and Governor, so that King and Queen is entitled to 12 Delegate Votes

For the District Convention, each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes cast or majority portion thereof for the Republican candidate in the most recent elections for President and Governor, so that King and Queen is entitled to twelve (12) Delegate Votes;

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of King and Queen under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, convention, or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of Republican Party, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party in the last five years.

A single exception to the above shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at

the time of the writing to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. A voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception as identified in this paragraph thereafter. In order to be eligible for election as a Delegate or Alternate to any convention, an individual be registered to vote no later than the pre-filing established by Official Committee or, if pre-filing is not a requirement, no later than the date of election as a Delegate. A person who has made an application for registration and meets all other requirements herein, but whose name does not appear on the local registration books solely because of the books having been closed in connection with a local election, will nevertheless be deemed a legal and qualified voter.

Pre-Filing Requirements

Candidates for election to positions of member of the King and Queen Republican Committee and/or Delegate (or Alternate) to the May 7th, 2016 1st District Convention and /or Delegate (or Alternate) to the April 30 2016 State Convention must submit the filing form found on the Republican Party of Virginia web site (RPV.org) which states intent to seek election for each specific position and which will include name, address, phone number, and e-mail and a voluntary fee (if applicable). All statements must be *received* no later than April 4, 2016 either in person or by mail (postmarks do not govern) at the following address: William H. Rilee, 299 Blands Folly Road, Shackelfords, Virginia 2356.

If the number of persons who file as candidates for Membership of the County Committee or to be a delegate or Alternate Delegate to any convention does not exceed the Maximum number that can be elected, then all properly pre-filed candidates shall be deemed elected.

Registration Fee

There will be no registration fee to participate in this mass meeting. The State Convention is requesting a Voluntary Registration Fee \$35.00. The

District Convention is requesting a Voluntary Registration fee of \$10.00.
These Voluntary Registration Fees are to be paid at the time of election as a
delegate or alternate to the treasurer of the King and Queen Republican Party.
